Perio Kit

The O'Hehir set of instruments are really useful, in that they can be used in multiple directions and can even get right down into the base of a pocket.

O'Hehir new Millennium™ Currettes have unique scoop blades with 270° radiused cutting edges. It's like having the toe of a curette without the interference of the remaining unused portion of a traditional blade. Can be used with either a push or pull motion, in vertical, horizontal or diagonal directions.
